

WHAT IS REQUIRED FOR AN EFFECTIVE TCCP?

1. TCCP leaders in each country must be committed to a vision for saturation church planting throughout that country.
2. Each TCCP must include all the evangelical churches possible located in the community. It must not be limited to one or two denominations or church groups.
3. **Each student church planter must carry out all of the “Action Plans” found at the end of Omega Course lessons.**
4. Each student church planter must have a mentor.
5. Students must emphasize personal evangelism (such as with friends, door-to-door, and the like) in the target area in which they are planting a new church. This follows the evangelism training of the Omega Course.
6. Each new TCCP must be started by holding a workshop for ten to thirty pastors from a variety of denominations (see the workshop handout for organizing a TCCP).
7. Each TCCP must be led by a Local Coordinator and a team of other coordinators as discussed in the “Organizing TCCP handout.”
8. The TCCP must uphold the policy that the student must start a cell group or a new church in order to receive a certificate of graduation.
